Michael Jaffrey Jordan is a former American basketball player. He was born on February 17, 1963. He is hailed by name as the 'greatest basketball player of all time.' He was instrumental in popularising the NBA around the world in the 1980s and 1999s. After a standout career at the University of North Carolina at Chapel where he was a member of Tar Heels' National Championship team in 1982, with his prolific scoring. His leaping ability earned him the

nicknames ' Air Jordan' and 'His Airness'. He also gained a reputation for being one of the best defensive players in basketball. In 1991, he won his first NBA championship with the Bulls and followed that achievement with many other titles. He holds the NBA records for highest career playoff scoring average. In 1999, he was named as the greatest North American athlete of the 20th Century by a popular TV channel. He was inducted into the Basketball Hall of Fame in 2009.

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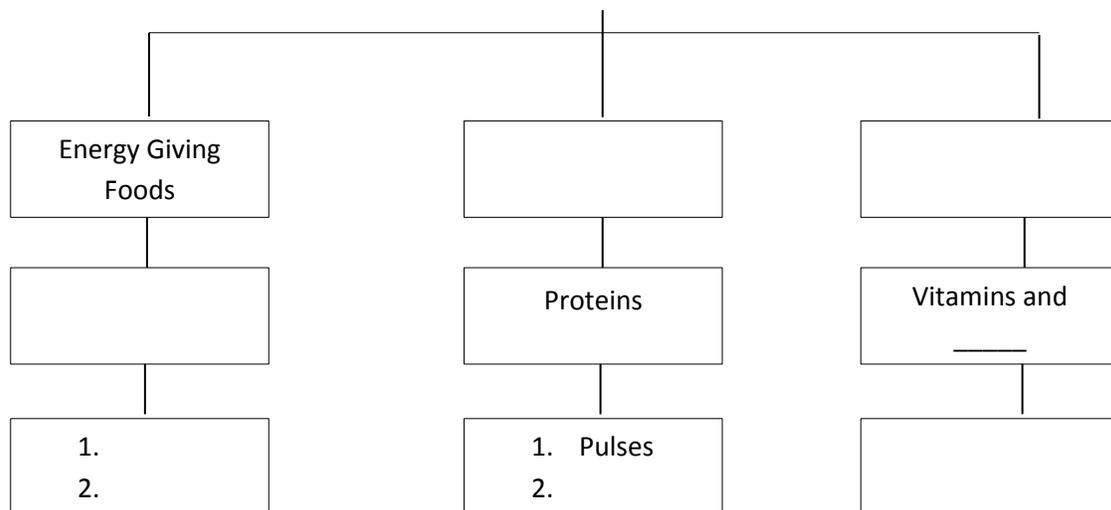
